He has had similar success in the area of real estate and land use, and in probate courts. Likewise, he has secured numerous international arbitration awards reaching as high as \$50 million.

For example, Glen was featured in *The Wall Street Journal* for his representation of Tropicana Condominium, and Waldman Barnett won a jury verdict of \$26 million, in a protracted case by nearby homeowners against the development of Privé at Island Estates in Aventura's Dumfoundling Bay, which opened in 2018.

Similarly, as reported by *The Miami Herald*, Glen led a successful effort to stymie developers who were intent on changing the landscape of the Grove Isle community located in Coconut Grove, Florida.
